Electoral Roll

Every six years the Church has to scrap its existing Electoral Roll and create an entirely new one. This is to ensure that the roll is as accurate as possible. The Electoral Roll is the list of Church members who are eligible to vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting. To be on the Electoral Roll you need to be a baptised member of the Church over 16 years of age. If you have not been baptised the Vicar be pleased to arrange for this to be done. One other important thing is that if you wish to take part in the government of your Church as a representative of the laity on PCC or Synod you must be on the roll.

Application forms will be available in the Church and in the Church Centre from Sunday 6th of January and if you can return them to me ideally before 31st January it would be much appreciated although the Roll will still be open until March. Many thanks Mac
